

RSF "Behavioral Camp" 2024

We are happy to announce plans to hold the 15th Russell Sage Summer Institute in Behavioral Economics, which has been held biennially since 1994. The camp will take place from the evening of Saturday, June 29 to the evening of Monday, July 8, 2024, at [Endicott House](#), an historic estate and conference center managed by MIT, located 12 miles from the city of Boston. The Institute will be organized by David Laibson and Matthew Rabin, with visits throughout by leading researchers in behavioral economics. In January we will post (here, on the Russell Sage Foundation website, and elsewhere) a formal announcement with more details, including the set of visiting faculty and more details about the program, the application process, and a timetable for admission.
